ORDER

The President having signed into law the Bankruptcy Amendments and Federal Judgeship Act of 1984, on July 10, 1984, and whereas,

Section 157(a) Chapter 6 of Title 28 United States Code, states that "Each district court may provide that any and all cases under title 11 and any or all proceedings arising under title 11 or arising in or related to a case under title 11 shall be referred to the bankruptcy judges for the district."

In accordance with this provision it is ORDERED that all cases under title 11, U.S.C. and all proceedings arising under title 11, U.S.C. or arising in or related to a case under title 11, U.S.C. pending on this date or filed on or after this date in the Western District of Virginia are referred to the bankruptcy judges for this District, to be assigned in accordance with their assignment rules.
